From the Principal's Desk

The Importance of arriving on time for School Every Day

St. Johns County Schools are required to track the number of student tardies and absences for reporting purposes. During the first quarter of the 2016-17 School Year (August through October), the Average Daily Attendance, (the percentage of students who are in school minus tardies and absences) was 95.6%. During that period of time, an average of 20 students arrived late for school without an excuse, as compared to an average of 13 students arriving late without an excuse last year. Although our school enrollment has increased by nine (9)

percent this year, the average tardy rate represents a 35 percent increase in the number of tardy students or four (4) percent of the entire school population.

Parents and guardians, please make sure your children arrive on time for school every day.

The school day at Crookshank officially begins at 8:30 a.m. Students are expected to arrive between 8 and 8:30 a.m. When children are tardy in the morning, their day is always adversely affected because they miss important introductory information and they become stressed and feel that they are catching up all day. I encourage all parents to make sure your children arrive at school on time every day. If you are having difficulty getting started in the morning, please consider allowing your child to ride the bus if that is an option. Thank you for making your child's on-time arrival at school a priority.



Regular School Attendance makes a Difference in Learning Gains



During the first quarter of school an average of 23 students were absent from school without an excuse, as compared with an average of 15 students last year. Our students can learn school-related things only when they are at school and we depend on your cooperation to meet your child's fullest potential. It is important that your child is at school every day, except when s/he is sick or there is a genuine family emergency. We appreciate your cooperation in this important area!
