• Update on Technology – Student I-pads have begun to be distributed by Josh Chowski, our IT Tech. They have been distributed to PreK and Kindergarten, 1st Grade. There are 420 I-pads total. Third through fifth grade will get more depending on the class size. It is

- going to be a good thing for students to have that learning tool, especially in small groups.
- The new projector-It was supposed to be installed in January, just got installed yesterday. It is beautiful it looks like a high-def TV. The sound has been fixed. Movie night tomorrow and PAW awards will be greatly enhanced.
- Summer Science and Writing Camp-This is for our rising 4th and 5th grade students. Right now, we have fifteen participants, and we have room for thirty. Keep pushing that message out to the 3rd and 4th graders to participate. There will be two sessions, the first will be held June 5th-20th and the second June 26th-July 13th.
- PMA3's Testing window opens up on the 17th -28th of April for K-2. Then our third graders will start May 1st, followed by their math exam on the second of May. Makeup exams will be the 17th-25th for everybody. The testing schedule will be sent out to parents Friday, the 31st.
- A Wellness Navigator-Employee starts with us on April 4th. She will mainly be working with Ms. Bailey Benoit to assist parents with access to dental, vision, and medical services. She will work with Nurse Roxanne, to get those services to our families.
- Summer Reading Program-Will start May 12. Miss Thomas has a full staff we are just waiting on how many students we will have for that. We can probably have up to fifty, but it will probably be closer to the forty range. It is funded by a grant so we will see how many students we can accommodate for that.
- Challenge Island After School-Started Tuesday, the 28th. Students participating can go up to twenty or even more than that if we want to add somebody to teach it. We had an okay turnout of about five families for the presentation. They had a lot of fun participating in the STEAM activities, and we are hoping to get more participants once the word gets out.
