

i-READY Testing for Distance Learners

Parents and/or guardians,

The testing window for Diagnostic Test 2 opens on Monday, January 11, 2021. Your student is highly encouraged to attend i-READY testing at Crookshank on the following dates:

- January 19 and 21 at 9AM for K-5 Math
- January 25 and 26 at 9AM for K-5 Reading

Check in will begin at 8:50AM. All students **MUST** wear a mask during testing. All students will have their temperature screened upon arrival. All students will have an assigned seating area and assigned laptop and headphones.

While you can test at home, we encourage our students to test at school in order to obtain the most accurate data. This progress monitoring data is used to guide your child's instruction and identify areas in which your child may need interventions. Should your child test at home please make sure to:

- Have a quiet area for your child to test.
- Only test for a maximum of 45 minutes.
 - *This is why we have two testing dates; it should take two sessions to complete the diagnostic.*
- Have your child take their time.
- Have your child complete the diagnostic **independently**.

Please note for grades 3-5: The results of this diagnostic is used to predict your child FSA score. At this time, our 3rd-5th grade students will take the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) in the spring. More information on the FSA to follow.
