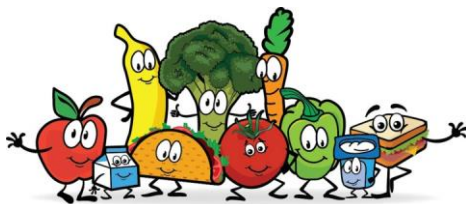
Cougars With Character

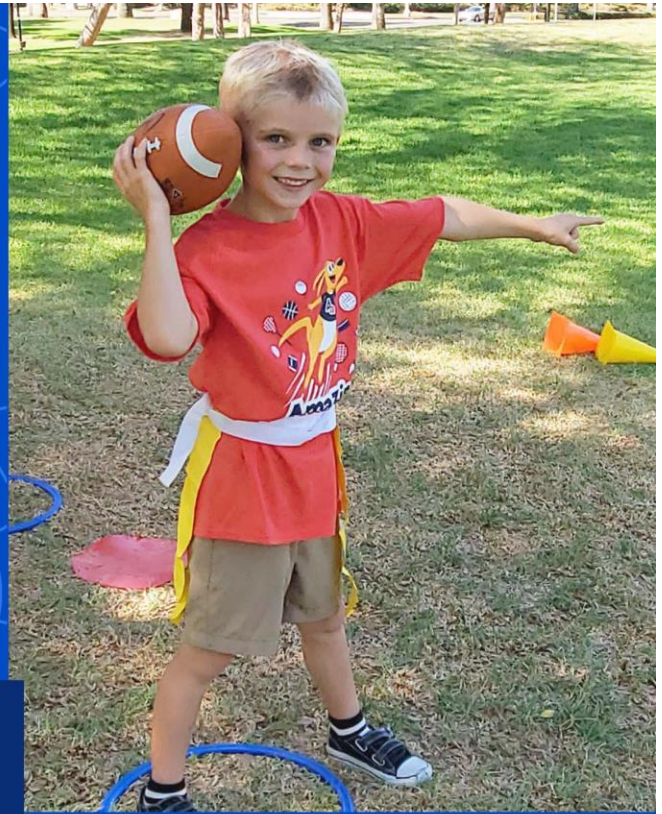

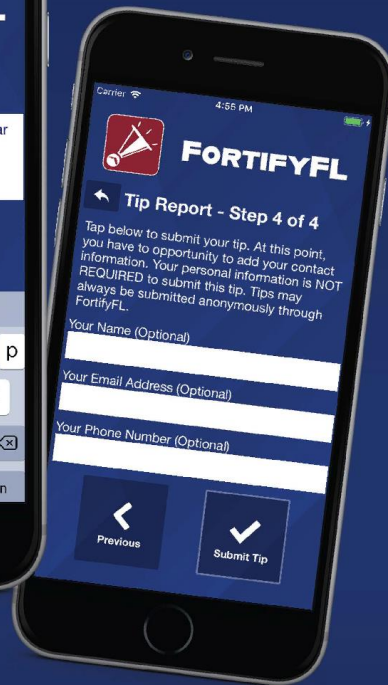
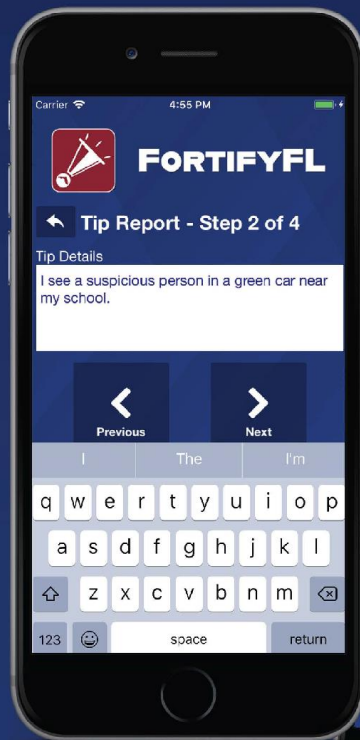
