Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival begins at 8:00 a.m.

No student should be on campus prior to 8:00 a.m. unless enrolled in the CES Before-Care Program.

Car Riders: Student may enter the building starting at 8:00 a.m. Please ensure your child only exits the vehicle on the right (sidewalk) side of the vehicle.

Walkers: Walker gates are reserved for students and families who walk to and/or from school. Walker gates are open at 8:00 a.m. The playground area is unsupervised by faculty at this time and should not be used.

Dismissal begins at 2:45 p.m. all days except Wednesdays. On Wednesdays, students are dismissed at 1:45 p.m.

Car Rider: Dismissal can often be a long wait, however each day gets better and better. Please be patient as we learn new names and faces.

Things to remember:

- You must have a 22-23 parent pick up card. If you don't have one, please park and go to the front office.
- Please stay at the numbered pole until your student has arrived, unless asked to park.
- Do not pull up unless you have your child, or someone directs you to pull up.
- Line up your passenger door with the opening in the fence in order for us to safely load your child into the car.
- Refrain from using cell phones in the car rider loop. This is for the safety of you and the students.
- Please be mindful of the people in the neighborhood and don't block driveways.

Walkers: Walker gates are reserved for students and families who walk to and/or from school. The playground area is unsupervised by faculty at this time and should not be used. Please do not park in the gravel lot and walk up.

What is Schoology?

Schoology is an online tool that manages curriculum, assessments, grading and other classroom management tasks and is also a communication platform for educators and students in grades K -12.

This tool will be an integral part of how teachers design and implement their lesson plans, assignments and grades. They will use it to post updates to their class and communicate with parents. Parents will be able to see what their children are working

on.

Visitors on Campus

We welcome parents and guardians to our school. We ask that all visitors enter the building only through the front office where they can obtain a dated pass. This pass is to be worn on the upper right left shoulder area while on school grounds. You must also present a state-issued ID to obtain entrance to the main campus. When you have been approved you will be able to sign in as a "volunteer". This is the terminology that indicates the system has completed a background check. Even if you are not planning to volunteer, we ask that you use this sign-in option to indicate that you have completed the School Access Form

Dear St. Johns County Parents,

Welcome back to school! I am thrilled to share that there will continue to be a Deputy Sheriff in each St. Johns County public school within our jurisdiction. The St. Augustine Police Department will also have officers placed at RB Hunt Elementary, Ketterlinus Elementary, Gaines Alternative School, and St. Joseph Academy. The partnership between our agency, the school district, and most importantly the families and students is vital to our success as a county.

As your Sheriff, I challenge all parents to continue being an active participant in your child's life. Their future depends on it. As a youth coach in St. Johns County for nearly 30 years, I've seen first-hand the importance of strong mentorship and involvement with our youth.

For me and this agency, there is nothing more important to us than the safety of our students. Our Youth Resources Deputies under the leadership of Captain Peggy Tennyson have spent the summer training so they are prepared for any situation that may occur during the school year. I cannot stress enough that if you see something, please say something. If it is an emergency, please dial 911 or for a non-emergency, call 904-824-8304. We will always put the safety and well-being of your children first.

I also challenge both parents and students to get to know your respective school's Youth Resource Deputy. The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office Youth Resource Deputies are there for each of you. If you hear or see something you think isn't right or you have a question about, reach out to them. It is paramount that our students know that the deputy in a uniform is a friend and there to be a resource to them.

I would also encourage you and your child to utilize the FortifyFL app to report suspicious information that is learned by our schools and students. These tips are relayed to law enforcement and school officials for immediate investigation. It is incredibly important for parents to remain vigilant and aware of their children's activities at school and elsewhere.

Finally, I'd like to thank you for your continued support of law enforcement in St. Johns County. It is truly our honor to be of service to you. 
