Once you have installed the app, you will have to confirm your relationship to your student by certifying that you are a parent or guardian. Once you have done this you will be able to see your student's progress with PBIS Rewards.

You can add more than one student to the app, even if they go to different schools, as long as the school is using PBIS Rewards. We encourage you to talk with your student about what they must do to be successful with PBIS Rewards and to encourage them when you see them being successful.

This will allow us to enter the donations into the fundraising site, so students receive their credit toward prizes. Donations will be accepted beginning *Friday*, *November 1st* until *Wednesday*, *November 21st*.




