School Start Time – The Impact of Tardies

Just a reminder that classroom instruction begins at 8:25 am. It's important that students are in their seats so instruction can begin promptly.

If a student is consistently 5 minutes late to school each day, here's how that adds up over time:

5 day school week:

5 minutes/day × 5 days/week = **25 minutes/week**

4 weeks in a month:

25 minutes/week × 4 weeks/month =100 minutes/month That's 1 hour and 40 minutes per month.

A school year (180) days:

5 minutes/day × 180 days/year = 900 minutes That's 15 hours per school year.





Procedure for School Access

As required by Florida state law, everyone MUST have a cleared background check to go past the front office at John A. Crookshank. Your driver's license is required to enter the building at all times. A photo of your ID will not work as you will need to scan your Driver's License. You MUST have school access approval to volunteer at the school, attend any conferences, awards events or chaperone field trips.

Now is the time to go ahead and apply for school access if you have not already done so! Please make sure all spouses, grandparents, siblings over the age of 18, etc. who may visit the school are also approved to enter the building.

Enter all required information (including first, middle and last name). You will receive an email when your application is received and when it is approved. The Raptor system will send you an email when your school access is expiring and will prompt you to update your application.

The front doors will remain locked during school hours. Front Office personnel will request visitors state the nature of the visit before the doors will be unlocked. If there are multiple visitors, all visitors will need to respond before being able to enter. We appreciate your patience and understanding as the safety of our students is paramount. 
